• The Center for Health Science innovation was established in 2013 at Grand Front, Osaka as a core of excellence for the research of Health Science. Under the slogan “Base Camp for leading the way to innovation of Health Science”, all members of the research team gathered to create new results in the area of Health Science i.e. to produce new products and services through academia-academia collaboration, industry-academia collaboration, and further, collaboration with medical institutions.

• Execution of “Health-Tec Startup Program”

At the Innovation Center for Health Science, we are offering Acceleration Program (scheduled to be started in 2020) in cooperation with Osaka Business Development Agency to produce new services that would change the life style in the field of Health Care.

【Development of human resource】

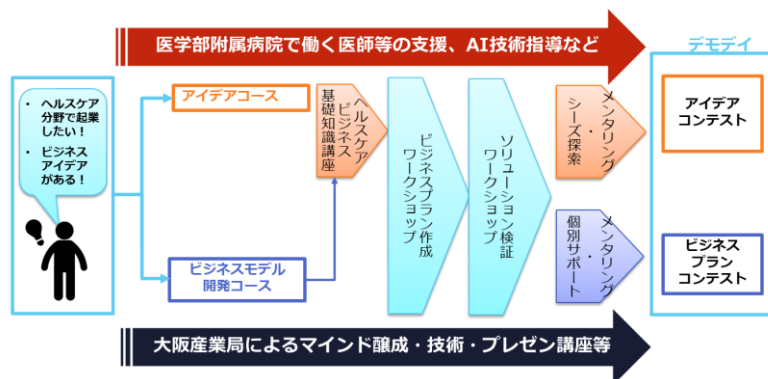
Train young researchers in the research field of Health Science, as well as, development of highly professional manpower such as coordinators, who would contribute to the promotion of industry-academia collaboration.
